AB 16-10 Ordinance 230 – Donnelly City Zoning Ordinance

Ordinance of the City of Donnelly, repealing and replacing the Donnelly City Zoning Ordinance and providing an effective date.

Stayton made a motion pursuant to Idaho Code Section 50-902 that the proposed Ordinance 230 pass its first reading by title only. Roll Call Vote: Davenport – Yes, Getto – Yes, Stayton – Yes. Clerk read title in full.

Davenport made a motion, pursuant to Idaho Code section 50-902, that the rule requires ordinances to be read on three different days with one reading to be in full to be dispensed with and that proposed Ordinance 230 be considered read, passed and adopted after being read by title only. **Roll Call Vote: Stayton – Yes, Getto – Yes, Davenport -- Yes**

Public Comment Period: Gene Tyler wanted to express the great work the Cami, City Clerk has done. He also commented on the impact to the Business Community on the decisions that are made. If McCall establishes a ban then Donnelly seems as though they are right in line with them. There is an assumption out there that Donnelly comes a lot to compare to McCall, for example the Sign Policy. Most business owners live outside of the town and do not have the ability to vote on issues concerning them or their business.
