

SUMMARY OF FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION 2007-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DONNELLY, IDAHO, APPROVING A FAIR HOUSING RESOLUTION FOR THE CITY.

A summary of the principal provisions of the Fair Housing Resolution adopted by the City of Donnelly on January 17, 1994 is as follows:

Section 1: Sets forth the purpose and intent of civil rights protection legislation and the areas to which the plan will apply.

Section 2: Sets forth the policy and procedure for carrying out activities in a nondiscriminatory manner in project assessment, processing, and decision making.

Section 3: Sets forth the assistance that will be available from the City to those who feel they have been discriminated against.

Section 4: Sets forth the steps the City will take to publicize this resolution and give notice to the public of the City's policy and procedures concerning nondiscrimination.
