THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLY  
VALLEY COUNTY, IDAHO  
ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS AND DRAINS, PRIVATE SEWAGE DISPOSAL, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF BUILDING SEWERS AND THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND WASTE INTO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLY, VALLEY COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to place, deposit, or permit to be deposited in an unsanitary manner in or upon public or private property within the Village of Donnelly any human or animal excrement, garbage, or other objectionable waste.


SECTION 2. The owner of all houses, buildings, or properties used for human occupancy, employment, recreation or other purpose, situated within the Village of Donnelly and abutting on any street, alley or right of way in which there is now located or may in the future be located a public sanitary or combined sewer of the Village, is hereby required at his expense to install suitable toilet facilities therein, and to connect such facilities directly with proper public sewer in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance within one year from the effective date hereof or within 90 days after date of official notice to do so whichever date is later, provided that said public sewer is within 125 feet of the property line.

SECTION 3. Prior to the connection to any public sewer facilities written permission to connect to the sewer shall be obtained from a member of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Donnelly, Idaho. Such permission shall not be denied unreasonably but shall only be granted upon the applicants assurance that the connection shall be made in the proper and approved manner.


Any person, firm, corporation or association violating this ordinance or any part or portion of the same shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in the sum of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00. Each day that the violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense under this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Should any parts of this ordinance be held to be illegal and not the ordinance in whole, then the parts of the ordinance not declared to be illegal shall remain in full force and effect.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION AND LETTING OF A FRANCHISE OR PRIVILEGE TO ESTABLISH, ACQUIRE, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE A TRASH AND GARBAGE COLLECTION AND SANITARY DISPOSITION SYSTEM THEREOF IN THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLY, VALLEY COUNTY, IDAHO, FOR BOTH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PURPOSES, WITH RIGHTS OF WAY AND PRIVILEGES OF USE OF STREETS AND ALLEYS FOR THE ABOVE PURPOSES FOR 1 PERIODS OF ONE YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLY, VALLEY COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO:

SECTION 1. That a franchise is hereby created and granted and ordered to be let for 1 periods of one year to establish, acquire, maintain and operate a trash and garbage collection and sanitary disposition system thereof in the Village of Donnelly, Valley County, State of Idaho, for both public and private purposes, with rights of way and privilege of use of streets and alleys for the above purposes in accordance with the conditions, terms, and limitations of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Donnelly, Valley County, Idaho, after the passage of this ordinance to contract with individuals, partnerships, corporations or other firms for garbage and trash disposal within the Village limits subject to the terms of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation owning or exercising such franchise or privilege, may sell, assign or transfer the same, but only on the written legal consent, by ordinance
